Financial Peace University is a life-changing program that teaches you how to make the right decisions with your money. You'll be empowered with the practical skills and confidence needed to achieve your financial goals and experience true financial peace. Each of the lessons deals with a different topic that will change the way you think about personal finance. Dave teaches about how to save money, live on a budget, communicate about money, eliminate debt, find bargains, and experience the joy of giving.

Over 650,000 families have completed FPU with amazing success. On average, they pay off \$5,300 in debt and save \$2,700 in just 13 weeks. That's an \$8,000 change in position in just 91 days!
